



Directions for Initiating a Background Screen

Following are step-by-step directions that will guide members through the process of initiating and completing a USA Swimming Background Screen.

Special Note: If you use Microsoft Internet Explorer as your web browser, this online process is optimized with Explorer 6.0+ or 7.0+. It is recommended that you update your computer to one of these versions of Internet Explorer. It is also necessary to have the free [Adobe Acrobat Reader](#) software installed in order to access and read the “Terms of Usage.”

- 1) Go online to <http://www.usaswimming.org/bgscreeninfo> and use the special button that will link you to the TC logiQ web site to initiate a screening request for a USA Swimming Background Screen.
- 2) The first screen is the “**Step 1: Secure Payment**” screen where you will enter information and execute payment via credit card.
- 3) After payment is complete, you will be directed to the “**Step 2: Create Account & Provide Information**” screen. You will be asked to provide the following information:

* Insert “None” if you do not have a middle name.

** Use the drop down box to select the LSC in which you are registered. If you are not sure of your LSC, check “US”

*** The formula for determining your USA-S ID# is as follows: Your six-digit birth date (mmddyy) + the first three letters of your legal first name + middle initial + first four letters of your last name. If you do not have a middle initial or last name four letters or longer, the missing characters are a star (*). John Chu would be mmddyyjoh*chu*.

- 4) You will also be asked to disclose any previous arrests or convictions in a text box.
- 5) Next, you will create a username and password in order to create your TC logiQ account. The final step on the Step 2 screen is to read and agree to the TC logiQ “Terms of Usage.” On the next screen, the “**Step 3: Verify Your Information**” page, please review your information and make changes or confirm and continue.

- 6) Once you confirm your information, you will be directed to **“Step 4: Initiate Background Screening Search.”** Click the button to actually initiate your background screen and be sure to note the information provided below the button.
- 7) The final screen is the **“Step 5: Print Confirmation”** screen. Please print this confirmation page. There will be times when a coach initiates his/her background screen and does not receive email confirmation of membership approval prior to the screening deadline for his/her LSC. In the event that your screening process has not been completed prior to your next swim meet, you will need this receipt as proof that you have initiated the screening process. Please note that this receipt is valid for coach access to swim meets for only 30 days from the date of issue.
- 8) Once you complete the process, you will be able to go online to the TC logiQ website at anytime to check the status of your screen and/or to review your search history. Simply go to www.tcllogiq.com and enter your username and password. Also, should you ever misplace your confirmation page from Step 5, you will be able to reprint a confirmation receipt on your account page.
- 9) Until TC logiQ reviews the screening report generated by this process, the applicant’s “Screening Status” on TC logiQ’s website will reflect “Pending”. Normally, a decision regarding membership eligibility will be emailed to you within 3-5 business days. In a few situations, it may take up to 14 days to complete the process.
- 10) If you pass screening, the result will be updated to “Approved” on your account page on the TC logiQ website and be communicated electronically to the USA Swimming SWIMS database. The expiration date for your screening is reflected in the same manner as your coaches’ safety certifications.
- 11) If the background screen returns incorrect criminal information, you have the opportunity to dispute that information. No action will be taken regarding membership eligibility until that information has been reviewed and verified. Please see Question #5 in the separate FAQ document to learn how to challenge disputed information.
- 12) If the background screen returns a finding of a potential membership disqualifier, there is a process for appeal to an established USA Swimming National Board of Review panel. Please see Question #6 in the FAQ document to learn how to appeal a negative membership decision.

In order to maintain your 2007 USA Swimming coach membership in good standing, you are required to complete the new USA Swimming Background Screening process on or before the deadline assigned to your LSC. Please check the schedule published in the separate document titled “LSC Rollout Schedule” in order to find your LSC deadline.

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
