Condition of Sanction	The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2(4). The copy of such certification is on file with USA Swimming. Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA-S member coach, must be certified by a USA-S member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Rules	2017 USA Swimming and FGC rules will govern this meet. Safety rules as outlined by USA Swimming and as recommended by the referee, will be in effect. Two sessions only; timed finals. All events will be short course yards. Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits other than locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited.
Camera Free	The Florida Gold Coast Swimming CAMERA FREE ZONE policy is in effect at this meet. No person may use a camera or any other device capable of recording still or video images in the area behind the starting blocks, in the locker rooms, changing areas, showers or restrooms. Violators may be reported to law enforcement or other governmental authorities and/or may be barred from the facility during the sanctioned event.
Image Authorization	All participants agree to be filmed and photographed by the official photographer(s) and networks(s) of USA Swimming under the conditions authorized by USA Swimming, and allow event organizers the right to use names, pictures, likenesses, and biographical information before, during or after the period of participation in USA Swimming competitions to promote such competitions. Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present. Exceptions may be granted with prior written approval by the vice President of Program Operations.
Eligibility	Open to all current 2017 USA swimming registered athletes – although the focus is on developing swimmers - and foreign athletes with proper travel credentials who have been invited by USA Swimming. Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from

within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement - USA Swimming Rule 202.3.3 The Meet Host will not be accepting New or Renewing USA Swimming registrations at the meet. All registrations must be done prior to the start of the competition.

Disability Athletes	All swimmers are welcome at this meet. Any athlete with a disability will be accommodated. Please contact the pool office ahead of time to allow for preparations. (561) 210-2128 or saintandrewsaquatics@gmail.com.
Deck Change	Changing, in part or whole, into or out of a swimsuit (excluding a drag suit) is an area other than a permanent or temporary locker room, bathroom, changing room or other space designated for changing purposes while at a practice, competition or other pool-related activity.
Pool & Timing	25 yards x 50 meters heated outdoor pool. 8-10 short course racing lanes with separate warm up and warm down lanes available. Omega Timing System with Daktronics scoreboard will be used. Fly over starts will possibly be used. The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2 (C). Water depth at the start varies from 5'6" to 9'0" depending on lane assignment accordance with 202.3.7 (C).
Date & Time	Saturday, September 9, 2017 Deck opens at 1:00 PM for warm up / Meet starts at 2:00 PM Adequate warm up lanes will be provided. Meet director reserves the right to change meet warm-up, start times, or drop some events in order to hold an efficient meet within USA Swimming/ FGC guidelines and with Age Group Chair approval.

Directions	Saint Andrew's School is located on Jog Road in Boca Raton between Yamato and Glades Road. The Duff Tyler Aquatic Complex is located at the south end of the main parking lot next to the basketball court.
Entry	All entries must be received by Saturday, September 2, 2017 Please enter electronically. NO MAILED ENTRIES. For electronic entries (CL or SDIF format only!) E-mail entries to saintandrewsaquatics@gmail.com. Confirmation of electronic entries will be sent via e-mail Submission of electronic entries signifies that all swimmers are USA registered.
