Sanction: The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2 (C).

Water depth at the start is at least 4'6" in accordance with 202.3.7 (C).

Date & Time: SEPTEMBER 23, 2017

Session 1-Timed Finals - Warm-up 8:00am. Meet starts at 9:00am

Session 2- Begins 10 minutes after session 1 is finished. Warm up and warm

down pool is available during session 1.

SEPTEMBER 24, 2017

Session 3 - Timed Finals - Warm-up 8:00am. Meet starts at 9:00am

Session 4 - Begins 10 minutes after session 3 is finished. Warm up and warm

down pool is available during session 3.

Pool/Timing: Competition is in the Sunrise Civic Center Pool 50 meters x 25 yards heated

outdoor pool. 8 short-course racing lanes will be used. Separate warm-up and warm down lanes will be available. Daktronics Timing System® will be used.

Rules: 2017 USA Swimming and FGC rules will govern this meet. Safety rules as

outlined by USA Swimming and as recommended by the referee, will be in

effect. All sessions are timed finals for all swimmers.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement - USA Swimming Rule 202.3.3

Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials, and/or spectators are present.

Deck Changing:

Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited.

Camera Free:

The Florida Gold Coast Swimming CAMERA FREE ZONE policy is in effect at this meet. No person may use a camera or any other device capable of recording still or video images in the area behind the starting blocks, in the locker rooms, changing areas, showers or restrooms. Violators may be reported to law enforcement or other governmental authorities and/or may be barred from the facility during the sanctioned event.

Image Authorization: All participants agree to be filmed and photographed by the official photographer(s) and network(s) of USA Swimming under the conditions authorized by USA Swimming, and allow event organizers the right to use names, pictures, likenesses, and biographical information before, during or after the period of participation in USA Swimming competitions to promote such competitions.

Eligibility:

Open to all current 2017 USA swimming registered athletes and foreign athletes with proper travel credentials who have been invited by USA Swimming.

The Meet Host Will Not be accepting new or Renewing USA Swimming registrations at the meet. All USA Registrations must be done prior to the start of the competition.

There are no Qualifying Times. (Meet Entry limit is 400 swimmers and/or to comply with the 4-hour rule.)

Disability Athletes:

Entry Deadline:

All entries must be received by Wednesday, September 13, 2017 @ 6pm EST. Meet Entry limit is 400 swimmers and/or to comply with the 4-hour rule.

Entry Limit/Procedure: Three events per session. The 400 IM, 500 free and 1650 free are positive check in events. Deadline for positive check-in is 10am. These events will be seeded fastest to slowest, and alternating girls and boys. They will be swum as

counters.

PLEASE enter electronically, NO MAILED entries. For electronic entries (CL or SDIF format only!!) E-mail to mail to:coachchristiw@aol.com Corrupted, unreadable or incorrectly formatted files must be corrected within 24 hours of entry deadline. Errors in entries submitted electronically are the

open, but scored separately. 1650 swimmers must provide their own timers and

Deck Entries: THE FGC DECK SEED POLICY WILL BE IN EFFECT. Deck entries

permitted into open lanes only on a first-come-first-serve basis. **COACHES ONLY, PLEASE**. Deadline for deck entries is 30 min. before start of meet. Policy can be seen at www.fgcswim.org. All deck entered swimmers must be current USA Swimming members in order to be entered.
