BB time standards have been calculated for the 50's of the strokes and 100 IM in the 13&over age group.

When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement 202.4.9(D).

Directions and Parking: When on US1, turn onto Stanford Drive and continue driving straight over Ponce de Leon. This is the main entrance into the University. The street is lined with palm trees and there is a guard shack on your left. Go through the left side of the guard shack. They most likely will let you pass without stopping you but if they do, just say you are there for a swim meet at the UM pool.

Parking Options on Campus - There is metered parking all along Stanford Drive. The meter cost is \$1 per hour. If possible, park in a meter closer to the roundabout at the end of Stanford Drive. The hours for the meters on campus are from 9 am to 10 pm. Pavia Garage is also open for parking, the cost is \$1 per hour, and the hours are from 9 am to 10 pm. Be aware of the metered spots on Stanford Drive have time limits. Pavia Garage parking is much more flexible.

Date & Time: July 6th-7th

Session I: Saturday - Timed Finals - Warm-up 9 am. Meet starts at 10 am **Session II:** Sunday - Timed Finals - Warm-up 9 am. Meet starts at 10 am

*Meet director reserves the right to change meet warm-up, start times or drop some events in order to hold an efficient meet within the USA Swimming/FGC guidelines and with Meet Committee approval.

Pool/Timing: 25-yard x 50 meters heated outdoor pool, 8 short-course racing lanes with separate warm-up and warm-down lanes available. Colorado Timing System will be used. Fly-over starts will be used as necessary. The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2 (4). Water depth gradually varies from Lane 1 to Lane 8 from 4.87 ft to 7.41 ft.

Rules: 2019 USA Swimming Rules and Florida Gold Coast rules will govern this meet. Safety rules as outlined by USA Swimming and as recommended by the referee will be in effect.

*MAAPP-All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.

Deck Changing: Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms, bathrooms, or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited.

Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas, and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present (unless it has been approved prior to the event).

Closed deck: Spectators will only be permitted in designated areas of the pool deck unless they are registered with USA Swimming as an athlete or as a non-athlete working the meet. The only exception is for timers and volunteers assisting with the conduct of the meet. Coaches will be permitted inside of the roped areas of the pool deck provided they have shown proper credentials to the meet host and do not interfere with those conducting the event. Coaches are requested to wear their coaching credentials or wrist bands at all times.

Camera Free: The Florida Gold Coast Swimming **CAMERA FREE ZONE** policy is in effect at this meet. No person may use a camera or any other device capable of recording still or video images in the area behind the starting blocks, in the locker rooms, changing areas, showers or restrooms. Violators may be reported to law enforcement or other governmental authorities and/or may be barred from the facility during the sanctioned event.

Image Authorization: All participants agree to be filmed and photographed by the official photographer(s) and networks(s) of USA Swimming under the conditions authorized by USA Swimming, and allow event organizers the right to use names, pictures, likenesses, and biographical

information before, during or after the period of participation in USA Swimming competitions to promote such competitions.

Conflict of Interest: Unauthorized sale, advertisement, and promotion of products and/or services at the location of the competition as well as its vicinities are not allowed without the written request and written approval of the meet host and meet director. All requests must be submitted to the meet director no later than 10 days prior to the first day of the competition. Failing to comply with such order will result in removal from the facility and/or immediate vicinity.

Eligibility: Open to all current 2019 USA Swimming registered athletes on an FGC registered team in Dade County who **have not yet achieved a BB time standard in the event in which they are entered.** 13 & Over events will have time standards for 13-14, and 15+.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement - USA Swimming Rule 202.3.3. The Meet Host **WILL NOT** be accepting New or Renewing USA Swimming registrations at the meet. All USA Registrations must be done prior to the start of the competition.

Entry Deadline: All entries must be received by Monday, July 1st by 6 pm

Entry Limit: No more than four (4) individual events per day.

Entry Procedure: Electronic entries only (CL or SDIF format).

**Submission of entries certifies that all swimmers are current USA Swimming registered.

NOTE: Swimmers without a registration number or birth dates will not be entered.

Refunds: Once a team or individual entry has been received and processed, there will be no refunds unless FGC Rule 1.17a.i.v applies.

Deck Entries: No deck entries will be accepted for this meet.

Seeding: Short Course Yards times only will be used for seeding. All events 200 and shorter will be seeded slowest to fastest.

An email confirmation of entries will be sent to each team. Any changes to entries including updating times must be done prior to Wednesday, July 3rd at 3 PM. Once this deadline passes and the psych sheet is sent out no further changes to entries may be made.

All 13 & Over events will be swum together and scored separately (13-14, 15+).

Awards: Medals 1st-3rd; Ribbons 4th-8th in each event by age groups

Scoring: This competition is not scored.

Admission: \$2.00 per session. Heat sheets will not be sold at the meet. Heat sheets will be available online for free at www.teamunify.com/fgha or on Meet Mobile. Copies will be posted around the pool deck. Coaches' heat sheets will be available at the starter's tent.
